Finmeccanica wins contracts for approximately EUR 100 million

Finmeccanica has won contracts with a total value of approximately EUR 100 million through its companies Ansaldo Energia, SELEX Sistemi Integrati and DRS Technologies.

Specifically, Ansaldo Energia has won a contract worth approximately EUR 75 million from Fingrid, the Finnish national operator for the production and distribution of electricity, to supply a power-generation unit based on two AE94.2 gas turbines for the new reserve power plant to be built in Forssa (Finland).

SELEX Sistemi Integrati and the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) have signed contracts with a total value of USD 19 million for the supply of eight radars. The sensors will be located at four different sites and will be part of the radar network in charge of the air traffic control over the crowded South Pacific air routes.

DRS Technical Services, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Finmeccanica Group company DRS Technologies, has been awarded a contract worth USD 15 million to supply X-band satellite connections and ground transport services to the US army stationed in the Middle East.
