Ansaldo Energia signs two contracts worth 340 million Euro in Algeria

Ansaldo Energia, a company of the Finmeccanica group leader in the supply of power generating equipments and services, has received today official confirmation of the award of two important contracts in Algeria, for an overall amount of 340 million Euro.

Ansaldo Energia returns to be a key player in Algeria consolidating its thirty-year presence in the Country, winning two international tenders after competing with the main world suppliers of gas turbines. The contracts envisage the turnkey supply of the power plant of LARBAA (close to Alger) and BATNA (150 km East of Alger), two 330 MWs power plants, equipped with two V94.2 open cycle gas turbines each.

Through these acquisitions, Ansaldo Energia takes up to 2450 MW the overall capacity of the power plants that it has supplied to SONELGAZ, Société Algérienne de l'Electricité et du Gaz, thus covering around 30% of the Country's installed capacity.

Both contracts envisage an important supply of spare parts and maintenance services. These results reconfirm the status of Ansaldo Energia as one of the main international suppliers of power plants in the Mediterranean, with good opportunities for the acquisition of other important contracts in the near future.
