Ansaldo Energia wins new contract in Algeria worth 350 million Euro

Ansaldo Energia, a Finmeccanica company and a leader in the supply of components and services for power generation plants, has won another important contract in Algeria, worth 350 million Euro.

Sonelgaz, Algeria's electricity and gas agency, has awarded Ansaldo Energia the contract to supply the M'Sila power plant. This order follows just over a month after the company won contracts worth a total of 340 million Euro to supply the Batna (300 MW) and Larbaa (300 MW) power plants. For the M'Sila contract, Ansaldo Energia will supply a turnkey power plant based on two V94.3A gas turbines generating total power of 500 MW.

This order, which also includes significant supply and service activities, strengthens Ansaldo Energia's presence on the important Algerian market, where it has been operating for more than 30 years in close collaboration with Sonelgaz.
