Ansaldo Energia signs orders worth over 100 million Euro in Russia

Ansaldo Energia, a Finmeccanica company and a leader in the supply of components and services for power generation plants, has signed two important contracts in Russia with Power Machines, the main Russian manufacturer of power generation systems. The two contracts are worth a total of more than 100 million Euro.

The two contracts are for the supply of five V64.3A gas turbines, including generators and auxiliary systems, for the combined cycle plants of Tyumen, in Western Siberia, and Pervomaiskaya, near Saint Petersburg.

The contract to supply the machines also includes the provision of the main spare parts.

These orders, which follow other recent international successes, confirm that Ansaldo Energia is a major world player, able to attain a position of leadership in one of the world's main markets. Given the need to modernise and replace its existing power generation plants, Russia offers some excellent opportunities, in light of the strong recovery in demand for energy.
