Ansaldo Energia at work on the Turano/Bertonico Lodigiano power station for Sorgenia

Ansaldo Energia, the Finmeccanica group company and leading supplier of components and services for power generation plants, has recently begun work on the construction of a combined cycle power station rated about 800 MW in the Municipalities of Turano / Bertonico Lodigiano. The company was awarded the turnkey supply contract following an invitation to tender with bids put in by the main international competitors.

The new order is particularly important for the company, as it represents the first contract awarded to Ansaldo Energia by Sorgenia, Italy's leading private operator on the national electricity and gas market.

The new plant is based on a 2+1 configuration, with two V94.3A gas turbines and a steam turbine designed and built at Ansaldo Energia production facilities.

Ansaldo Energia has also been awarded a Long Term Service Agreement to maintain the gas turbines and associated generators.
