

ENVIROMENTAL POLICY

Ansaldo Energia s.p.a. considers environmental issues to be an integral part of corporate policy and strategy, and it manages its production processes with a view to protecting the environment by optimising their use of natural resources and raw materials.

Corporate management, with a view to the continuous improvement of its environmental performance in connection with the following activities:

- design and installation of thermal, geothermal, gas turbine and hydroelectric plants;
- design, manufacture and installation of gas turbines, steam turbines, electric generators and electric motors;
- routine maintenance and repair work on customer request;

has decided to apply and actively maintain, both at its main production site and in erection and service sites, an Environmental Management System in compliance with UNI EN ISO 14001 standards to guarantee:

- compliance with the law and regulations regarding environmental protection and other applicable requirements, including those stipulated in contracts with its Italian and international Customers, for the prevention of pollution and continuous improvement;
- the identification and update of environmental impact factors (direct and indirect), as well as the risks deriving from activities, products and services in its own sphere of competence and from those of third parties over which it can reasonably exercise some degree of control;
- reduction of the environmental impact and related risks of its activities, products and services and the prevention of pollution.

With reference to the above, Ansaldo Energia has set itself the following objectives:

- to reduce waste and the consumption of resources (materials, fuels, power and water resources);
- to recycle resources where possible as an alternative to landfill dumping.

In order to achieve these objectives, Corporate Management undertakes to provide the human resources, specialist skills and technologies needed, as well as adequate financial resources to implement and monitor the operation of the Environmental Management System.

Corporate Management is represented by a Environment Health and Safety Manager appointed to ensure that the requirements of the Environmental Management System are established, implemented and maintained in compliance with applicable legislation and company directives.

Company personnel involved at all levels must ensure that the requirements of the Environmental Management System are applied effectively in their sphere of competence.

This Environmental Policy document is filed in the corporate Information System, available for consultation by personnel and kept up to date in relation to the objectives the company decides to pursue.
