To whom it may concern,

The below has been prepared by Achilles and authorised by the UVDB Steering Group Chairman, Ian Bartle on behalf of suppliers in the UVDB community and should be considered when reviewing a UVDB Verify audit report or certificate at the present time.

Following the outbreak of the COVID-19 coronavirus the United Kingdom Government introduced a series of measures to help stem the spread of the virus. Considering this, the UVDB Steering Group and Achilles have worked together to develop a temporary audit programme solution. This is with the aim of maintaining business continuity during these unprecedented times and providing assurance to the buying community.

Following the success of a virtual management system audit, it was agreed that all UVDB Verify audits would be undertaken remotely as of the 18th March 2020. The site aspect (where relevant) of the UVDB audit programme has been placed on hold and a score of 0% has been awarded as a temporary measure. The 0 score is not a reflection of a company's ability to provide services to its customers and will only remain valid until the site audit has been undertaken and full assurance can be provided to the buying community.

The organisation in receipt of this document has undergone a virtual management system audit and has temporarily been awarded a site score of 0 to reflect the above decision of the UVDB Steering Group. During these unprecedented times the company should be commended for their approach in maintaining the continuity of their systems and their readiness to be audited.
