

NUCLEAR SAFETY POLICY

The undersigned, as Chief Executive Officer, is committed to establishing, implementing and maintaining the Nuclear Safety Policy of Ansaldo Nuclear.

Ansaldo Nuclear considers Nuclear Safety as one of the fundamental principles to be considered in planning and performing its activities. All its activities are undertaken in accordance with the Company's Organizational Management System, Code of Ethics, Quality and Environmental Health and Safety Policy.

The Nuclear Safety Policy covers Ansaldo Nuclear activities for design, manufacturing, construction, installation, commissioning, operation and decommissioning of all nuclear installations, such as nuclear power plants and waste storage facilities.

In order to assure and achieve a strong Nuclear Safety, Ansaldo Nuclear is committed to:

- Introducing a strong Nuclear Safety Culture at all levels of the Company: decisions taken at all levels take into account the responsibilities concerning Nuclear Safety
- Maintaining organizational well-being together with safe and clean work environments
- Promote the reporting of identified issues and incentivize the submission of effective suggestions for improvement
- To enable the reporting of issues without fear of repercussions and sharing knowledge and information about issues widely
- Implementing a Quality, Health, Safety and Environment Management System that promotes and supports a strong Nuclear Safety Culture which takes into consideration the attitudes of both the Company and personnel with respect to Nuclear Safety and the activities they perform
- Ensuring the periodic review of the Policy and the Quality, Health, Safety and Environmental Management System, in order to guarantee their effectiveness and congruence with the actual situation, revising them, if necessary.
- Ensuring that Nuclear Safety is always our top priority in activities that can involve the risk of exposure to ionizing radiations for workers, population and environment
- Ensuring that Nuclear Safety is not compromised by other priorities
- Ensuring the availability of skilled resources, using and actively developing their competences, knowledge and aspirations, in line with business needs
- Satisfying the requirements of our customers and stakeholders and complying with all relevant laws, regulations and standards, regarding the supply of Nuclear Safety related items or services
- Promoting awareness of the risk of Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items (CFSIs) in the supply chain and ensuring that the requirements to manage the risk of CFSIs are implemented and maintained
- Ensuring that lessons learned are communicated within the Company and the supply chain, sharing also examples of counterfeit or fraudulent items or services
- Identifying Key Performance Indicators and establishing, planning and revising objectives to improve Nuclear Safety
